
WHAT CRICKET FARMING ENTAILS





How to start

1Eggs from another cricket farmer or collect adult crickets from the wild.

2Hideouts in the cage e.g. paper egg trays as crickets are nocturnal.

After 10-14 days crickets hatch. (Provide fine chicken growers mash to the young crickets till maturity. (Provide water through a sponge such as cotton wool or woollen blanket; pebbles stone

placed in drinkers are prone to contaminations.

After 2-3 months, under (temp 25-28oC); relative humidity (RH) of about 70%, they begin to lay eggs. Optimal production levels temp of 32OC; RH of 50%.

5 After 3months, crickets are harvested, blanched to be fried or further processing to produce flour

Uses of Crickets

- Fried in a pan
- Taken as snacks
- Prepared as stew
- Value addition
- Milled into fine flour
- Food fortification
